



EXPO VENUE

This premier expo will take place at the Sarit Expo Centre Nairobi from 3-5 October 2024. With contemporary architecture, Sarit Expo Centre is Kenya's largest purpose-built venue that is located within Sarit Centre mall at the heart of Westlands, Nairobi, Kenya. The Centre is 30 minutes' drive from Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, 10 minutes' drive away from Nairobi central business district. Endowed with diverse amenities within the expo area, Sarit Expo Centre provides a holistic venue for the ATLT expo 2024.

TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

For international delegates, please ensure you have the following printed documents in your possession for smooth clearance at the immigration section of Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA), Nairobi, Kenya:

- 1. Passport with at least six months' validity, and a Kenyan electronic travel authorization.
- 2. Proof of yellow fever immunizations if arriving from an endemic country
- 3. You must declare anything that may be prohibited or subject to tax or duty.

ARRIVAL AT THE AIRPORT

Upon arriving and clearance at JKIA, for those booking accommodation under the provided options, and who have indicated interest in getting transport, there will be a representative from Bonfire Adventures holding a pager with name of person, ATLT and Bonfire logos to offer transfer service to the respective hotel at a small fee as indicated here https://atlt.foventa.africa/expo-accommodation/

Delegates opting for different accommodation apart from the provided options, can use alternative transfer options including digital taxi apps such as Uber and LittleCab, accessible on the android phones google play store or the apple phones app store. Alternatively, the chosen hotels can provide transfer services to be discussed with the respective hotel in advance based on the flight schedule.

REGISTRATION

All participating exhibitors and delegates are encouraged to register before the day of the expo via the links provided here; https://atlt.foventa.africa/. The deadline for registration of exhibitors is 30th August 2024 and that of delegates is 30th September. On-site registration and badge ID collection for registered delegates and exhibitors will be processed at the Arabuko hall entrance on the three days of the expo.

LANGUAGE AND CURRENCY

The main language of communication across the country is English and Swahili.

The local currency used is Kenya Shillings. Major currencies, including the US dollar, Euro, Chinese Yen, Indian Rupee, UK pound, Japanese Yen, etc can also be changed with ease within the city and within the Sarit Centre Mall itself. Please visit the CBK link https://www.centralbank.go.ke/forex/ to get an indication of the exchange rate for various currencies. The exchange rates however vary with time ad establishment.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Display of materials that contain sand, water, soil, gravel and rocks likely to damage floor tiles must be communicated in advance with the organizing team for proper guidance.
- 2. Display of easily flammable or explosive substances, gases or hazardous substances (including chemical pesticides and insecticides) or foul- smelling substances or radioactive sources should be communicated to the organizing team in advance. Open or live flames are not allowed within the exhibition arena.
- 3. Display or demonstrations involving use of open, flowing, sprayed and/or atomised liquids (e.g. through air conditioning systems, fountains, high pressure cleaning equipment, saunas, whirlpools, etc.) should be communicated beforehand and shall comply with all applicable rules
- 4. Smoking is not permitted in the Expo centre.
- 5. Chewing gum is not permitted in the Expo centre.
- 6. Animals or pets are not permitted in the Sarit Expo Centre without the prior written consent.
